Louise Cameron Scholarship High School Student Application

What is the High School Student Scholarship?

The high school student scholarship gives high school graduates the opportunity to further their education at an accredited college, university or technical/vocational college. The scholarship award helps cover the cost of tuition, fees, books, supplies, and other related expenses.

What scholarships are available for the 2018-2019 academic year?

The Inter-Community Council, Inc. (ICC) awards the Louise Cameron Scholarships annually to high school graduates and adult residents of the Athens Housing Authority (AHA) to further their education. The ICC awards a total of \$3,000 in increments of \$1,000 or other designated amounts depending on the number of scholarships awards.

Scholarship applicants will be notified of their status by May 18, 2018. Scholarship awards will be announced and presented at the Inter-Community Council, Inc.'s Annual Meeting in June 2018.

Who can apply for the scholarships?

In order to be eligible for a High School Student Scholarship, you must be a resident 17-19 years old and graduating from high school during the 2017-2018 school year. The resident must meet the following criteria:

- Current resident named as an occupant on the lease at the Athens Housing Authority.
- Must be accepted in a full or part-time undergraduate course of study at an accredited two or four-year College, university, or vocational/technical school.
- Must have a 2.7, or higher, grade point average.

What is the deadline to apply?

Your completed application must be turned in to the Inter-Community Council, Inc. office, located at 156 Parkview Homes, by 2:00 p.m. on Monday, **April 30, 2018**. Applications received will be date and time stamped. Applications received after the date and time deadline will not be considered.

What is the process for applying?

- Application packets are available from the Inter-Community Council, Inc. office, Athens Housing Authority's front desk, Clarke Central and Cedar Shoals High School Counselors' offices.
- Read and complete the entire application. If you have questions, contact the Inter-Community Council, Inc. at (706) 208-1774 before the submission deadline.
- Applicants are required to submit an official high school transcript **in the original sealed envelope.**
- Applicants will submit an official copy of SAT/ACT scores.
- ICC **will not** give assistance for remedial courses. Please provide a copy of the College Placement Exam (CPE) score.
- Applicants must provide a letter of acceptance from the college, university, or technical/vocational school you will be attending.
- Three reference letters supporting the character, achievements, and advancement of the applicant. One letter must be from a school official. The other letters may be from employers, ministers, or anyone with significant knowledge of the applicant.
- Applicant must submit an essay, **typed** on a separate sheet of paper(s), double-spaced, a twelve (12) point font with a maximum of 400 words describing reasons for pursuing your education.

Applicants are responsible for gathering and submitting all needed information by the deadline.

How will the award be distributed?

ICC will send the check to the school. If tuition and books are covered by other scholarships, the Inter-Community Council, Inc. Scholarship Award may be paid directly to the student, upon request.
